
ORDER OF DETERMINATION

At a Session of said Court, held at the Courthouse in the Village of Centreville,
in said County on the 30th day of March 1972.

PRESENT: The Honorable Robert E. A. Boyle, Circuit Judge.

This cause having been brought on to be heard upon the Petition for the
Determination and Fixing of the Natural Height and Level of the Waters in Sand Lake and
in Lake Templene as proposed, filed therein by Leonard E. Bullard, Assistant Prosecuting
Attorney for St. Joseph County, Michigan, and proofs having been taken in open court,
the Petitioner having been present together with Richard A. Wade, of Weiner, Wade and
Tucker, Counsel for the St. Joseph County Lake and Land Development Corporation, the
developer of Lake Templene, from which it satisfactorily appears to this Court that
the allegations set forth in said Petition are true;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the Natural Height and Level of the Water
in Sand Lake is hereby determined to be established at 828.5 feet above mean sea level,
and the Natural Height and Level of the Water in Lake Templene, as proposed, is also
hereby determined to be established at 828.5 feet above mean sea level.
